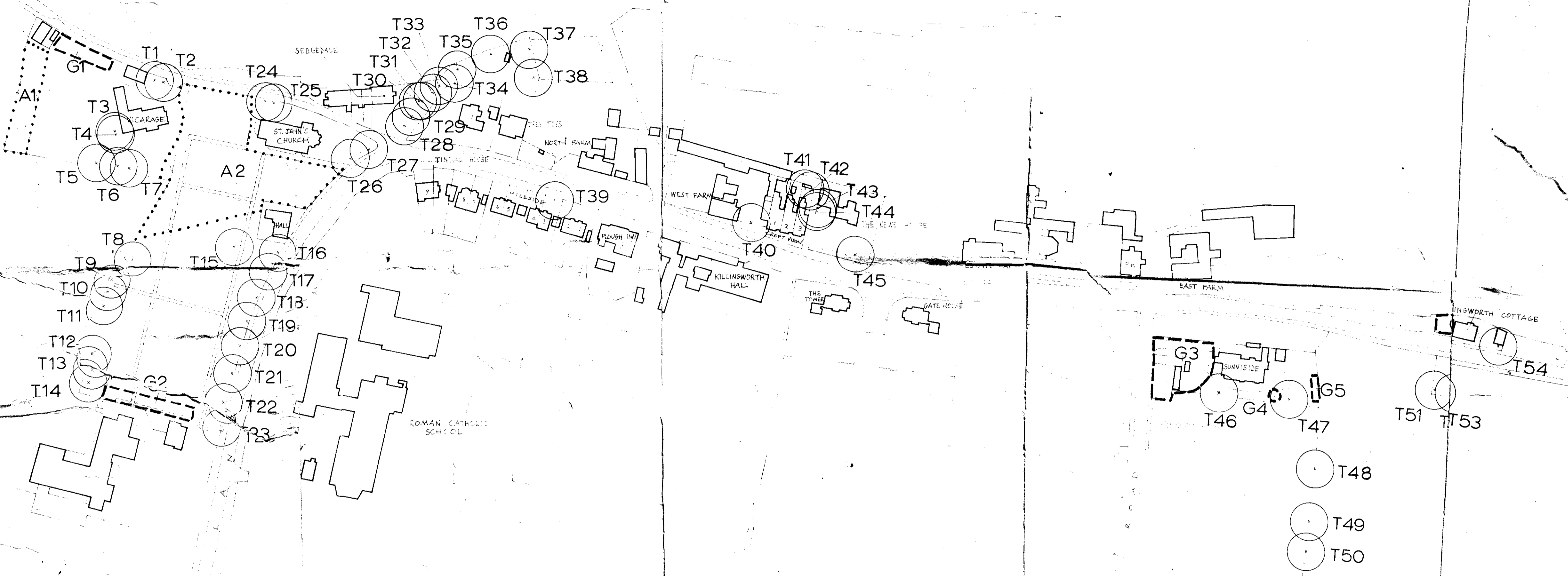

G.2.	Group consisting of 8 poplars, 67 sycamores.	Lying along the southern boundary of the grave yard of St. John's Church. <i>Extensive easterly sycamores situated by falling due to dangerous condition Spring 1910</i>
G.3.	Group consisting of 16 sycamore, 3 Hawthorn, 2 Ash, 2 Horse Chestnut, 2 Whitebeam, 1 Lime, 1 Willow	Lying immediately to the west of Sunnyside and to the east of Killingworth Road. <i>Felling of one whitebeam approved by C. H. C. Co. in 1909 to remove light obstruction.</i>
G.4.	Group consisting of 2 sycamore 1 whitebeam.	Lying approximately 22 feet to the south east of the south east corner of Sunnyside.
G.5.	Group consisting of 5 sycamore.	Lying approximately 85 feet east of Sunnyside.
G.6.	Group consisting of 4 sycamore, 1 elm, 1 hawthorn.	Lying immediately to the west of Killingworth Cottage. <i>Removal of 1 Sycamore approved due to dangerous condition. Sep. 1910.</i>
