

FIRST SCHEDULE

The map referred to is at a scale of 1:500 and is based on the 1:2500 O.S. Northumberland Editions of 1953 and 1961, sheets No. 2870 and 2871 respectively; and the area covered by the Order lies to either side of Green Lane, a public footpath formerly scheduled as Bridle Road No. 21, for a distance of approximately 700 metres north of West Lane, Killingworth Village and wholly within the Urban District of Longbenton in the County of Northumberland.

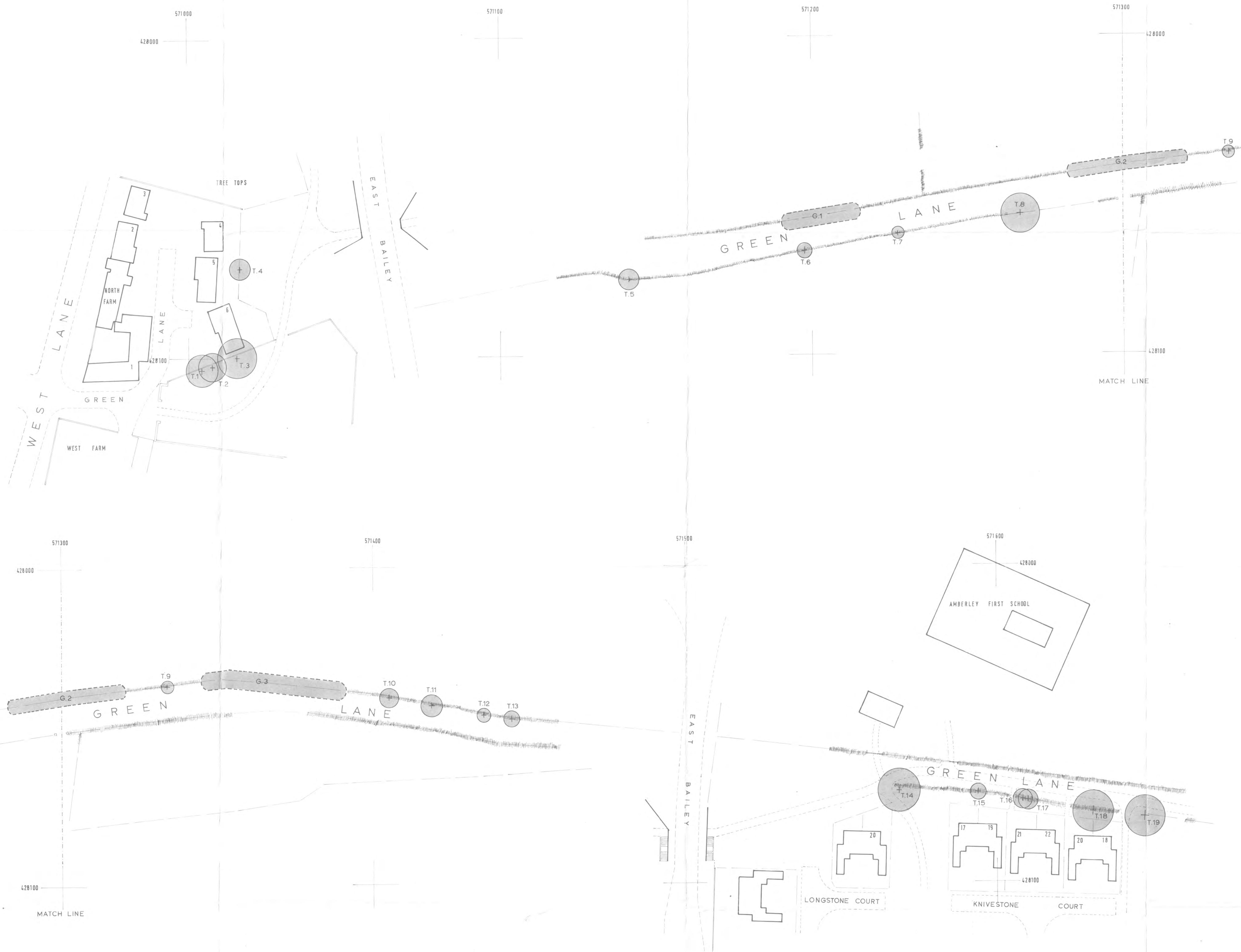
