

FIRST SCHEDULE

The map referred to is at a scale of 1:1250 and is based on O.S. sheet NZ3273 SE (1966).

The area covered by the order consists of the land adjacent to the east and south of the Bee Hive Inn, on Hartley Lane.

The area is wholly within the Borough of North Tyneside in the County of Tyne and Wear.

TREES SPECIFIED INDIVIDUALLY

No. of Map	Description	Situation
T1	Sycamore	Lies on the southern boundary of field No. 8638 immediately south of the Bee Hive Inn, measured 33mm eastwards along the boundary from the south west corner.  The following trees are measured from the south east corner of the original Bee Hive Inn, parallel with the face of the gable.
T2	Sycamore	52.5m eastwards from the corner and offset south 34.5m
T3	Sycamore	70.5m eastwards from the corner and offset south 18m

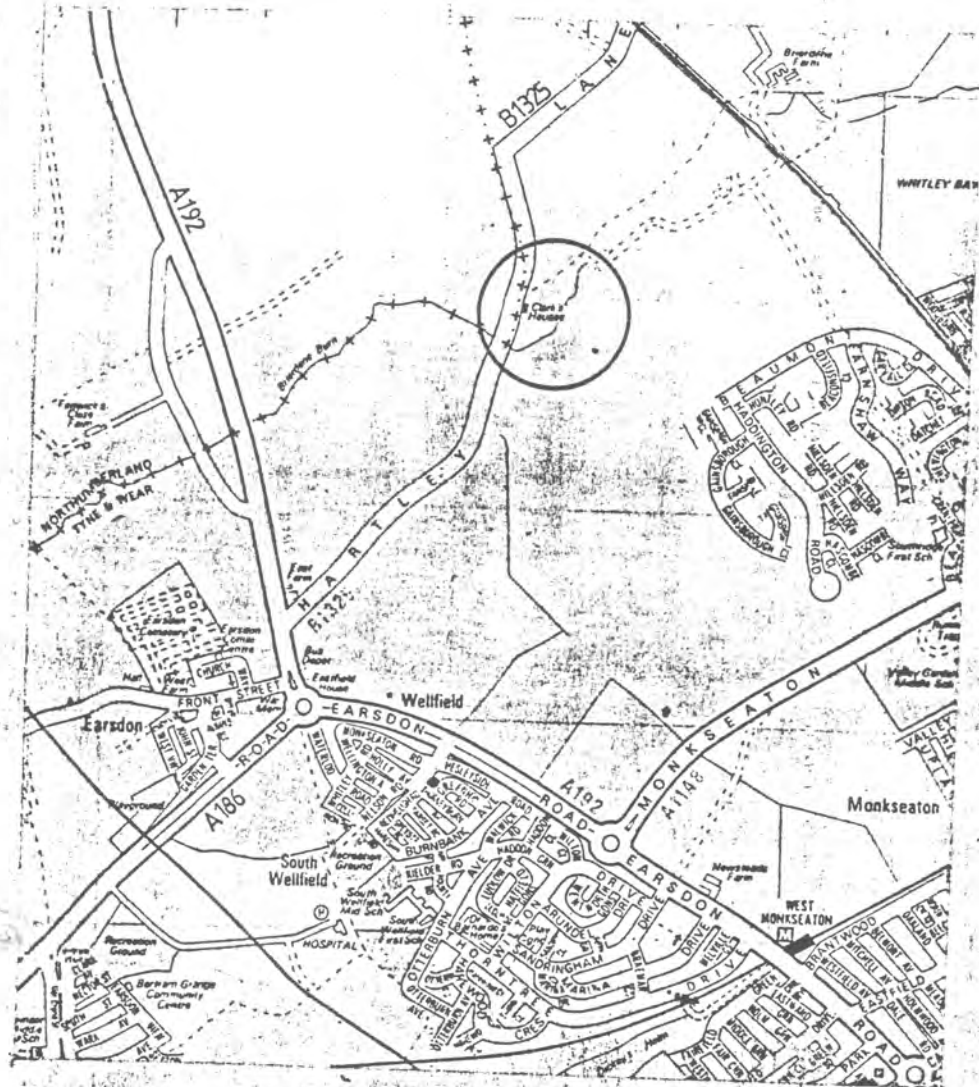
GROUPS OF TREES  
(within a broken black line on the map)

No. on Map	Description	Situation
G1	Group consisting of 1 Sycamore and 1 Willow	85m south of Bee Hive Inn, extending between National Grid Reference (NGR) NZ 3284 7332 and NZ 3284 7335.
G2	Group consisting of 3 Willows	Extending 30m along Brierdene Burn between NGR NZ 3288 7334 and NZ 3291 7336.
G3	Group consisting of 24 Sycamores 9 Ash and 5 5 Willows	Extending 140m along Brierdene Burn between NGR NZ 3294 7338 and NZ 3300 7350.

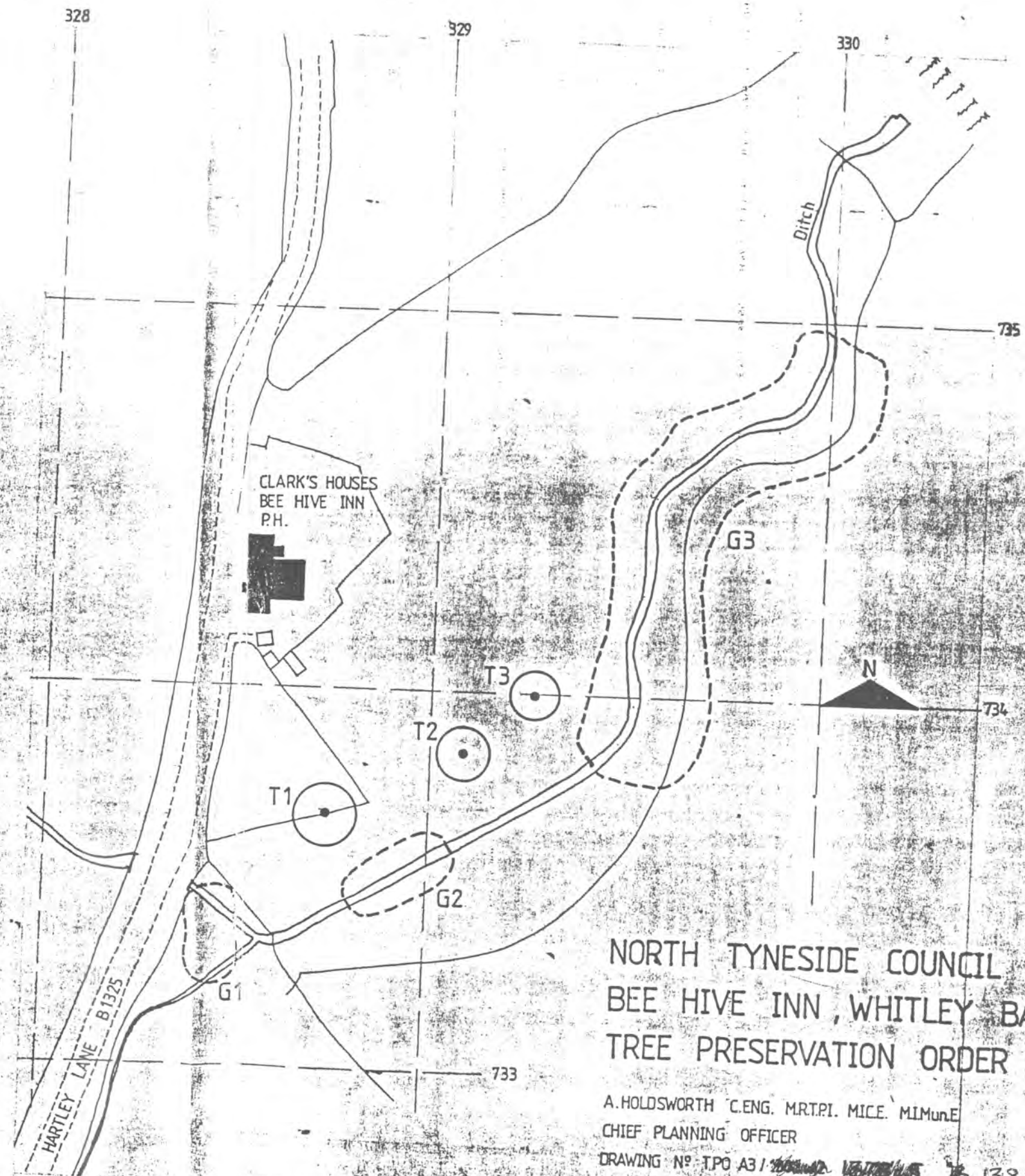
