The project we would like you to fund is made up of two key parts, 1) Sustainable energy 2) Accessible growing spaces Both elements of the project increase inclusivity and add value to a much-loved community asset based in the heart of Longbenton estate. We secured a 40 year lease in 2023.

The Longbenton Community Garden is located behind the Innisfree social club, the Longbenton metro runs parallel with the garden. The garden is 0.18 hectares in size, it is well established and offers a safe, sensory green space that residents of all ages enjoy, including local primary schools.

Sustainable Energy – We aim to connect our renewable energy to the national electric power grid, through Northern Power. This will enable us to use our modular building during all seasons, currently the modular closes throughout Autumn and Winter. The closure is forced, as the renewable energy/solar panels do not generate enough power during the Autumn and Winter. Without power the building is freezing cold and dark, simply not fit for purpose during those months.

Inclusion and accessibility – Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) We aim to install a disabled ramp to our modular building. We also would like to transform an area of land on the garden to increase disabled access, we will do this by building raised beds and laying accessible pathways. We also have plans to replace our very old polytunnel which is not fully accessible and in need of major repair.

We would also like to include costs to support us with a longer-term vision which includes opening a disused, heavily overgrown pathway. To achieve this, we will require planning permission and Net Gain Bio-diversity report and possibly an engineering survey. Without funding for this we will never get to the point of having a fully inclusive access/egress.
