In terms of controlling access for the PoC initial trial you can just let us know who needs access and when these people no longer have access. Please find attached a draft DPIA which outlines the potential access for officers in N Tyneside.

There are a few issues to discuss below that may be beneficial to jump on a call for which I hope you can assist with:

The two main elements that would need to be addressed when planning to go live with this change are:

- Auditing access – IMU stated that we need to be able to audit our use of the system. Is there some functionality built within the Council system to capture who has access what and when?
- Controlling access to the system – If we add officers within North Tyneside how will we ensure access is removed when no longer needed as they have moved to another area command or left the force. What is the JML process?

Please advise how you feel we can take this forward for consideration, approval, and future delivery.
